

As per the new Companies (Corporate Social Responsibility Policy) Amendments Rules, 2021, all form of NPOs (Section 8 company, registered trust or a registered society) not established by a Company needs to fulfil the following three conditions in order to obtain CSR funds and implement CSR activities:

- Have a valid registration under section 12A and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- Have an established track record of at least three years in undertaking similar activities.
- Has successfully registered with the Central Government by obtaining a Unique Registration number after filing form CSR-1.
